SkiingBoarding: Six lifts and 14 trails for skiing and boarding.

Tubing: There is no skill involved. Simply ride your tube, which is attached to a tubing lift, to the top of the hill and slide down one of our many chutes at speeds approaching 40 mph! The park was designed to be one of the most exciting tube parks around, all while making sure it is as safe as possible.
